INK POP will feature English translations of popular manga and manhwa, while also bringing popular webtoons series into print, for chapter book, middle grade, and YA audiences.


- MANGA is the Japanese word for "comic" and is read right to left
- MANHUA are Chinese comics; read from left to right
- MANHWA are Korean comics; read from left to right
- WEBTOONS are comics that are originally published online or in an app

OUR CUSTOM AGE/CATEGORY RATING SYSTEM

Traditionally, while Manga, Manhua, and Manhwa age categories are vague, we are following the CHILDREN'S guidelines to make this an even more accessible category for younger readers.

This is perfect for booksellers, parents, educators, and librarians looking for kid-friendly and kid-appropriate content for their young readers. These guidelines will make Ink Pop titles easier to shelve, and also easier to recommend to your customers

Anime made its mainstream debut on US television nearly twenty years ago in morning and afternoon blocks on standard and cable TV, raising a new generation of fans. These Millennials and older Gen Z viewers have now grown into their spending power. Anime and manga are no longer niche markets—they have a foothold in pop culture in all age groups. In fact, adult manga makes up a little under half of the total comics and graphic novel market. Kid- and tween-friendly manga exists but is underrepresented in the United States.


MANGA BUILDS VISUAL LITERACY




